Gary P. Motyl is chief investment officer of the Templeton Global Equity Group, which comprises institutional and retail assets. Mr. Motyl is also president of Templeton Investment Counsel, LLC. He has managed global and non-U.S. equity portfolios for over 25 years, and currently manages several institutional mutual funds and separate account portfolios and shares country research coverage of the United States.

Mr. Motyl has been employing Templeton's unique bottom-up value-oriented approach to global investing since beginning his career with Templeton in 1981. He was the third investment professional to be hired by Templeton's founder, Sir John Templeton, and worked closely with him for many years. Mr. Motyl became executive vice president of Templeton Investment Counsel, Inc. in 1996 and president in 1999. He was promoted to chief investment officer of Templeton Institutional Global Equities in 2000.

Prior to joining Templeton, Mr. Motyl worked as a research analyst and portfolio manager with Landmark First National Bank, where he had responsibility for equity research and managed several pension and profit sharing plans. Prior to that, he worked as a security analyst with Standard & Poor's Corporation.

Mr. Motyl earned a B.S. in finance from Lehigh University in Pennsylvania and an M.B.A. from Pace University in New York. He is a Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA) Charterholder.
