## What is this product?

### Type

The product is a share class of FTGF Putnam US Large Cap Value Fund (the "Fund") which is part of the Franklin Templeton Global Funds plc, an investment company with variable capital incorporated with limited liability in Ireland and established as an umbrella fund with segregated liability between sub-funds.

### Term

The Fund has no maturity date. The Fund could be closed under the conditions laid down in the current prospectus of the Fund.

### Objectives

#### Investment Objective

To seek long-term investment growth, mainly through growth of capital while seeking current income.

#### Investment Policy

The Fund mainly invests in equities of US companies of large market capitalisation. The Fund focuses on value stocks (i.e. companies whose share prices are undervalued according to the investment manager).

To a lesser extent, the Fund may invest in smaller or mid capitalisation companies and equity markets outside of the US.

**Derivatives and techniques** The Fund may use derivatives for reducing risks (hedging) and costs, and to generate additional income or growth (in accordance with the risk profile of the Fund).

**Strategy** The investment manager uses Fundamental analysis and quantitative tools to select companies that appear to have good financial strength and sustainable growth prospects.

**SFDR category** Article 6 (does not promote environmental and/or social characteristics or have a sustainable investment objective under EU regulations).

**Base currency** US dollar (USD).

**Benchmark(s)** Russell 1000 Value Index.

The Fund is actively managed. The Benchmark is used for performance comparison purposes and is considered by the Investment Manager in portfolio construction and monitoring investment risk.

### Share Class Policy

Income and gains from the Fund's investments are not paid but instead are reflected in the Fund's share price.

### Buying and selling shares

You may normally buy or sell shares on any day the New York Stock Exchange is open for business.

### Intended retail investor

Investors who understand the risks of the Fund and plan to invest for at least 5 years. The Fund may appeal to investors who:

- are looking for long-term investment growth
- are interested in exposure to US equity markets as part of a diversified portfolio
- have a high risk profile and can tolerate significant short-term changes in the share price

**Product availability** The Fund is available to all investors with at least basic investment knowledge, through a wide range of distribution channels, with or without the need for advice.

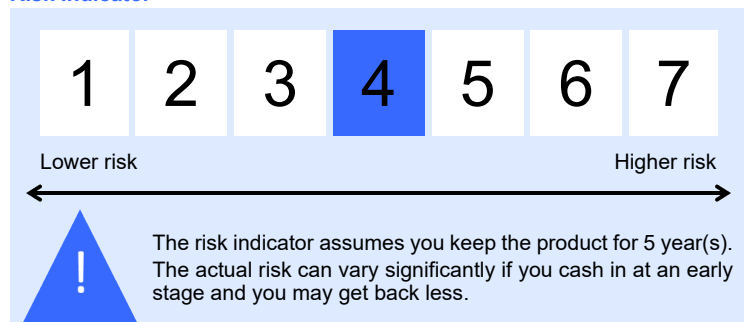

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### Risk Indicator

## What happens if Franklin Templeton International Services S.à r.l. is unable to pay out?

Franklin Templeton International Services S.à r.l. ("FTIS") is the management company of the Fund, but the assets are held separately from FTIS by the depositary. BNY Mellon SA/NV Dublin Branch, as the appointed depositary of the Fund, is liable to the Fund or its shareholders for any loss of financial instruments held in custody by it or its delegates (cash could however be lost in case of default of the depositary or its delegates).

There is no compensation or guarantee scheme protecting you from a default of the Fund's depositary.

## What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

### Costs over Time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario
- USD 10 000 is invested
